

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

JULY 15, 2024

The regular meeting of the Juab County Commission was held July 15, 2024, 10:00 a.m. in the Juab County Commission Chambers, 160 North Main, Nephi, Utah.

Chairman Palmer welcomed all in attendance. Commissioner Kenison offered a word of prayer. John Crippen led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Kenison made a motion to accept the minutes from July 1, 2024.

Chairman Palmer seconds the motion, no opposition, motion carries. All voted in favor.

Commissioner Kenison made a motion to accept the minutes from July 8, 2024.

Chairman Palmer seconds the motion, no opposition, motion carries. All voted in favor.

Chairman Palmer excused Commissioner Painter. He is out on a family vacation.

Milford Hall came before the Commission regarding a complaint about farm sprinklers watering roadways. He inquired if the ordinance was going to be enforced. Chairman Palmer stated it was discussed at last Commission Meeting and indicated Lieutenant Kenison had instructed that citizens should call dispatch for a formal complaint. Lt. Kenison indicated for a call to be generated, it needed to go through Dispatch. They can call the Sheriff's Office phone and then press the corresponding number for dispatch. Mr. Hall stated the roads are being destroyed by the extra water on the roads.

Other Business:

Commissioner Kenison made a motion to approve the Juab County bills as presented.

Chairman Palmer seconds the motion, no opposition, motion carries. All voted in favor.

John Crippen has one personnel action form for a new volunteer for EMS. Her name is Kendra Street. Commissioner Kenison made a motion to approve the EMS personnel action form.

Chairman Palmer seconds the motion, no opposition, motion carries. All voted in favor.

Attorney Davis received the 2024-2025 MOU for Indigent Defense Services between Juab County and the Utah County Public Defender's Association, as well as the State of Utah. This is a renewal of the same contract we have had previously. This year Juab County's portion would be \$157,232.40. Commissioner Kenison asked what the change was. For 2023, the amount was \$152,963.24. Commissioner Kenison made a motion to approve the MOU and authorize

Commissioner Clint Painter to sign the MOU. Chairman Palmer seconds the motion, no opposition, motion carries. All voted in favor.

Commissioner Kenison made a motion to adjourn the open meeting and move to the Closed Session for personnel issues. Chairman Palmer seconds the motion, no opposition, motion carries. Chairman Palmer called for a roll call vote.

Chairman Palmer voted, "Aye."
Commissioner Kenison voted, "Aye."

Commissioner Kenison made a motion to adjourn.
