# 2024 Recount and Audit Certification Report

If a race is eligible for a recount (<u>20A-4-401(3a)</u>) and is timely requested by the losing candidate, the recount shall be conducted within 7 days of the recount request (<u>20A-4-401(5)(a)(ii)</u>).

If you have any questions or encounter any problems, notify your liaison in the Lt. Governor's Office immediately.

Create a backup election titled "Recount."
Reset the results to zero before beginning the logic and accuracy test.
Print and sign and date zeros reports from the results database and from each piece of counting equipment. These reports should only list the CD2 race and results.
Conduct a Logic and Accuracy test (20A-4-104), and ensure that only the CD2 race is being reported.
Create a new back up election.
Reset the results to zero before beginning the recount.

Recount 20A-4-401
Review postmarks on all "too late ballots." Ballots that count must have a valid postmark
(June 24 or earlier AND have been received before noon on the date of your county
canvass) (20A-3a-204(2)). These ballots remain unopened during the review.
Review uncounted ballot envelopes under 20A 3a part 4. These ballots remain
unopened during the review:
Review all uncounted mail ballots that were challenged (20A-3a-401(3)).
Review all cured affidavits to ensure each corresponding ballot has been counted $(20A-3a-401(5))$ .
Ballots that were not cured before 5:00 pm three days before the original canvass
began cannot be counted (20A-3a-401(5)). (30 ball of 3)
Review all uncounted provisional ballots (20A-3a-402(1)). N

Nake detailed notes on any additional ballots that are being included in the
recount that were not in the original count.
Rescan all ballots ( <u>20A-4-401(b)(ii)</u> ) (For Salt Lake, this will include uploading all DRE ballots).
Verify and reconcile that all ballots have been counted, including UOCAVA and remakes.
Perform adjudication. Commit results.
Submit batch numbers to the Lt. Governor and conduct a 3% post-recount audit (State of Utah Election Audit Policy - Recount Audits). The audit will only be conducted on the CD2 race. The 3% will be of all ballots scanned in the recount. In some jurisdictions, the batches may contain ballots outside of the CD2 race. Those ballots can be skipped for this audit. Communicate with the Lt. Governor's Office as you progress through your count so we can be ready to turn the numbers around quickly.
Salt Lake will also need to audit 3% of DRE ballots cast and at least 1 machine per polling place.
Post-Recount
Complete final "OFFICIAL RESULTS" for the RECOUNT that only contains results for CD2
☐ Reconvene the Board of Canvassers immediately (20A-4-401(11)). Check with your commission/council and attorney on the noticing requirements (52-4-202).
☐ Boards of Canvassers shall canvass the CD2 results and transmit a report to the Lt. Governor that details the number of votes for each candidate (20A-4-401(11)).
☐ Sign a new audit summary report and send it and the signed canvass report to the Lt. Governor.
Upload recount results for the CD2 race to the state election results website. This will be the recount website, not the June 25 Primary website. Only post results after your canvass is complete.
Verify that the state results site matches the official county results.
☐ Publish the certified report of the board of canvassers as a Class A notice (20A-4-304(6)).
